The committee reviewed Jim Whitting's \$1000 donation to remove dead and fallen trees around the brook. The DNR is coming this month to remove the trees and debris that needs to be taken out. The committee will review the progress and determine if further clean-up is needed during the next meeting.

The committee was informed that a group from the Conservation Club was going to be doing weeding the buffer around the brook this month. The committee understands that any and all members were welcome to come and help.

The committee also discussed the need for a Chair. It was stated that this has been an ongoing issue and there were no volunteers or suggestions.

Park Walk Through – The walk through consisted of making a list of tasks that need to be done at the park either by city staff or volunteers i.e.: MN Teen Challenge or Sentence to Serve.

- White Pines need to be trimmed 9 feet high.
- Bridge handicapped pier – dedication ceremony.
- Grill has a wooden table on top of it – remove it.
- Add 2 more rocks before bridge so snowmobiles can't get through; they need to use the trail.
- Welcome sign with map of the park redone.
 - Distance/measure
 - North on the top
- Dead trees along the trail need to be cut down.
- Carving out the dead Ash tree by the bathrooms.
- Trail signs in (miles) not (km).
- Old signs on the trails taken down.
- Take down old gate.
- Men's room sign needs the letter 'N' added to it.
- Raking around swing set and slide.
- Thinning or taking out the overpopulated group of trees.
- Sign made with info on how to reserve the pavilions.
