The committee received the meeting minutes from the September meeting via email.

Terry Frovik suggested prioritizing the list of things that need to be done. If the tasks can't be done by city staff or volunteers he thought a grant could be applied for to complete the task. Kevin Egan suggested developing a 5-10 year strategic plan for the park.

Downed trees need to be cleaned up in the areas of the park. *

Clean up trails. *

Create a path to where the benches are placed.

Natural plants or shrubs near the stream.

Fix the doors on the bathroom. *

Add more signage on the trails. Todd suggested using a GPS to map the trails.

Repair the Cross Country Ski sign.

Add trail maps to the mailbox.

Remove weeds from swing area and add sand or recycled tires.

Possibly add a new piece of equipment, i.e.: jungle gym.

Cindy shared the goals from years past that can still be put into place.

Betsy suggested adding history/educational signs.

Kevin completed the Fritz Loven Park sign. He was reimbursed for his materials.

Betsy Egan has agreed to take the chair position for the park/recreation committee.

Krista read an email from Teri Hastings regarding the Shea/Evan Johnson property near the park. The Johnson's will be putting up signs that identify that a person is leaving public property and entering private property along the trail. They will be hunting on their property. They also said that they cleaned the trails in the park. Krista suggested sending the Johnson's a thank you note.

Todd asked what changes were suggested to the new brochure. Krista said they talked about a detailed map.
