

**MINUTES  
LAKE SHORE PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE  
MONDAY, MAY 11, 2015

Members present: Betsy Egan, Terry Frovik, Todd Peterson and Council Liaison Krista Knudsen. Cindy Terwilliger and Bob Wilmes were absent. Guest: Kevin Egan.

The committee reviewed the meeting minutes from the October 2014 meeting.

The committee members that could on their own time walked through the park before coming to the meeting. Betsy commented that the park itself looked good; however, the road at the park entrance isn't in very good shape. Terry said he and the people he was with thought there were so many trees down from wind damage. He suggested that the trails get cleaned up (possibly an Eagle Scout). Betsy asked if anyone is still intending to GPS the park trails. Krista said her husband would like to, but he is so busy right now. Betsy commented that the swing set area looks nice right now.

Kevin was in touch with someone from the U of M that helped Nisswa with their park and is willing to help Lake Shore. He said there is grant dollars available and he would be able to put together a visioning plan. Kevin said the Civil Air Patrol also has a group that may be willing to help out at the park.

Krista heard from a young man that is doing an arbor project through the Lutheran Church of the Cross and he would like to plant 500 trees at the park.

Krista said that Living Savior Church is looking at putting in park equipment so it may be redundant to add equipment at Fritz Loven. Maybe Fritz Loven should remain a park that caters more to hikers.

The directional signs for 77 and 78 may have been ordered last fall. Teri was looking for guidance from the county engineer.

The Brochure is almost done. Todd said the changes that Cindy suggested were made and his printer didn't work when he tried to print it. Still working on getting a better trail map made. The brochures can still be printed without a map.

The main concern is to assess if there are any trees over the trails. If the maintenance man can't clear them up maybe one of the groups mentioned earlier could do that. The docks over the trails need some repair. Krista will ask Teri about the condition of the road entrance into the park.

The meeting was adjourned.
